



FWI CENTENARY BUNTING

Each WI and Group is asked to make a pennant. These will be buttoned together to form bunting that will be used to decorate events during our Centenary in 2018.

A pattern has been provided for you to follow but the choice of fabric is yours.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Mark out the triangle shape on your fabric but **DO NOT** cut out until the design has been completed.
2. Create your design(s) to fit the shape. These can depict your WI or the area and be in any suitable medium. Ideally there should be a design on both sides.
3. Transfer your design to within $\frac{1}{2}$ "/1.5cm of the long edges and $1\frac{1}{2}$ "2.5cm of the top.
4. Cut out triangle and pin right sides (RS) together along the long sides.
5. Sew together using $\frac{1}{2}$ "/1.5cm seam allowance. Trim point.
6. Turn to RS and press flat ensuring the seam is at the edge. Leave the top edge open.

NB The pennant will be completed at WI House using appropriate tape and buttons.
